CORONAVIRUS UPDATE

Following the spread of Coronavirus (Covid-19) in Italy and the first emergency decree issued by the Italian Government on February 25th 2020, the center of Italy's outbreak of the coronavirus was put under quarantine.

The new emergency decree, approved on March 9th, applies to the entire country. The measures will remain in place until April 3rd.

Italy is now “orange zone” nationwide as **the new quarantine measures being put in place are less severe** than those in the previous “red zone”, where for the past two weeks, entry or exit were forbidden and all the activities have been on lockdown.

Within the orange zone there is **no absolute ban**, people are still able to use trains and planes to and from the region for proven work needs, emergencies, or health reasons.

All our plants and offices are operative and run at full speed.

Moreover, travel restrictions do not apply to business related freight transport: air, ocean and rail freight operations are allowed. Trucks can enter, exit and circulate within the orange zone areas and regularly run loading, unloading and pick-up services.

Cargo operations in Italy continue to run as normal according to the preventive measures implemented in accordance with governmental policies.
